WHAT WE ARE DOING

- Piloted the first incubator project by providing the support of experienced financial aid volunteers from UNiSON's core organizations and collaborators to guide and implement the 2023 FAFSA Sprint Project at Anson High School.
- Led the Raising a Reader Play poster contest in partnership with Anson Partnership for Children and Anson Schools. All K-5 children in Anson Schools participated in the contest. The judges were high school students recommended and selected by Anson High School teachers.
- Led Captain UNiSON costume design contest. Fifth graders from Anson Schools participating in April's career fair were given a copy of the Captain UNiSON comic book College Misconceptions ahead of time. During the career fair, students designed Captain UNiSON's costume. The winner was announced at the end of April.

WHAT OUR WORKGROUPS ARE DOING

ADULT LITERACY WORKGROUP

- Union and Anson county libraries are sharing names of volunteers interested in becoming Adult Literacy tutors with SPCC Adult Literacy Services.
- SPCC is tutoring the first Anson student in Anson as a result of this initiative at the Anson County Library.
- Added workforce literacy as a goal. It includes employability skills development and computer literacy. Union and Anson county libraries and SPCC are working together to achieve this goal.

COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS WORKGROUP

 Enhancing UNiSON's website to include a community calendar, project incubator submissions, and job/pathway information. Anson's collaborators have been instrumental in providing feedback and participating in the conversations.

RECRUITMENT AND CAREER AND COLLEGE READINESS WORKGROUP

- Defined Career and College Readiness indicators.
- Sharing FAFSA events with members.
- Supporting the 2023 FAFSA Sprint Project.

INCREASED 2023 FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA) COMPLETION RATES

2023 FAFSA SPRINT PROJECT

- Providing one-on-one expert assistance with Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to Anson High School seniors.
- Assisting 25 Anson High School seniors and their parents (23% of the senior class) with FAFSA completion.
- Increased by at least 10% the number of FAFSA completers.
- Over 40 hours of expert volunteer assistance.
- 16 FAFSA expert volunteers from 8 UNiSON member organizations:
 - Anson County Schools
 - Anson High School
 - Our Future in UNiSON
 - South Piedmont Community College
 Wingate University

ENHANCED COMMUNITY EVENTS

RAISING A READER PLAY POSTER CONTEST

- Enhanced participation from family and young children in Raising a Reader Play sponsored by Anson Partnership for Children by adding a poster contest.
- Over 95 attended the event, including elementary school children and their families.
- Over 800 K-5 children from 6 Anson Elementary Schools participated in the poster contest.
- 30 school winners and 6 district winners were selected.
- 14 judge applications from Anson High School students were received, and 6 were selected.
- 30 hours organizing and implementing the event provided by UNiSON.

INCREASED COMMUNITY AWARENESS

CAPTAIN UNISON COSTUME DESIGN CONTEST

- Informed families of learning resources and opportunities through the Captain UNiSON comic book College Misconceptions.
- 136 comic books were distributed to 5th graders participating in the Anson High School career fair.
- 95 entries received for the contest.
- In-kind donations totaling approximately \$1,500.
- 25 hours organizing and implementing events by UNiSON.
